






NATIONAL MINIMUM SALARIES 2017 – 2018



Ministerial Order no. 161/2007 of 31 December establishes the following sectors of activity for the purposes of setting the national minimum salaries::

- Sector 1 Agriculture, livestock, hunting and forestry;
- Sector 2 Fisheries;
- Sector 3 Mineral extraction industry;
- Sector 4 Manufacturing industry;
- Sector 5 Production and distribution industry;
- Sector 6 Construction;
- Sector 7 Non-financial services activities;
- Sector 8 Financial activities
- Sector 9 Public administration, defence and security.

In turn, article 108(5) of the Employment Law, approved by Law no. 23/2007 of 1 August, provides that "the Government, after hearing the Employment Consultative Committee, establishes the national minimum salary or salaries." The Employment Consultative Committee was created by Decree no. 7/94 of 9 March, as amended by Decree no. 2/2000 of 29 February.

Under the terms and for the purposes set out in the above article, the Government approved the new national minimum salaries with effect from 1 April 2017, published in the Mozambican official gazette (Boletim da República) number 74, Series I of 12 May 2017, as set out in the tables below:

SECTOR 1 -	- MINISTERIAL	ORDER NO.	31/2017	OF 12 MAY

Current Minimum Salary: 3642 MT (three thousand six hundred and forty-two meticais).

Previous Minimum Salary: 3183 MT (three thousand one hundred and eighty-three meticais).

Notes:

- (i) The readjustment rate is 10,43%.
- (ii) Repealed Ministerial Order no. 26/2016, of 11 May which established the minimum salary in Sector 1 in 2016/2017.

SECTOR 2 - MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 32/2017 OF 12 MAY		
Current Minimum Salaries:	Previous Minimum Salaries:	
(i) 4615 MT (four thousand six hundred and fifteen meticais) in industrial and semi-industrial maritime fishing;	(i) 3815 MT (three thousand eight hundred and fifteen meticais) in maritime fishing and semi-industrial;	
(ii) 3780 MT (three thousand seven hundred and eighty meticais) in kapenta fishing.	(ii) 3375 MT (three thousand three hundred and seventy-five meticais) in kapenta fishing.	

Notes:

- (i) The readjustment rates in industrial and semi-industrial maritime fishing, and in kapenta fishing are 20.97% and 12.00%, respectively;
- (ii) Repealed Ministerial Order no. 27/2016 of 11 May, which established the minimum salary in Sector 2 in 2016/2017.

SECTOR 3 - MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 33/2017 OF 12 MAY		
Current Minimum Salaries:	Previous Minimum Salaries:	
(i) 6963.67 MT (six thousand nine hundred and sixty-three meticais and sixty-seven cents) for work in large companies;	(i) 6213.67 MT (six thousand two hundred and thirteen meticais and sixty-seven cents);	
(ii) 5201.60 MT (five thousand two hundred and one meticais and sixty cents) for work in quarries and sandpits;	(ii) 4907.17 MT (four thousand nine hundred and seven meticais and seventeen cents);	
(iii) 4.731 MT (four thousand seven hundred and thirty-one meticais) for work in salt beds.	(iii) 4.476 MT (four thousand four hundred and seventy-six meticais).	

Notes:

- (i) The readjustment rates for work in large companies, work in quarries and sandpits and for work in salt beds are 12,07%, 6% e 5,7%, respectively;
- (ii) Repealed Ministerial Order no. 28/2016 of 11 May which established the minimum salary in Sector 3 in 2016/2017.

SECTOR 4 - MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 34/2017 OF 12 MAY		
Current Minimum Salaries:	Previous Minimum Salaries:	
 (i) 5965 MT (five thousand nine hundred and sixty-five meticais) for work in manufacturing industry; (ii) 4334 MT (four thousand three hundred and thirty-four meticais), as an exception, for the bread-making industry. 	(i) 5200 MT (five thousand two hundred meticais);(ii) 3985 MT (three thousand nine hundred and eighty-five meticais).	

Notes:

- (i) The readjustment rates in manufacturing industry and in the bread-making industry are 14.71% and 8.76%, respectively.
- (ii) Repealed Ministerial Order no. 29/2016 of 11 May which established the minimum salary in Sector 4 in 2016/2017.

SECTOR 5 - MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 35/2017 OF 12 MAY		
Current Minimum Salaries:	Previous Minimum Salaries:	
(i) 7286 MT (seven thousand two hundred and eighty-six meticais) for work in large companies;	(i) 6036.71 MT (six thousand and thirty-six meticais and seventy-one cents);	
(ii) 6.002 MT (six thousand and two meticals) for work in small and medium companies.	(ii) 5421.77 MT (five thousand four hundred and twenty-one meticais and seventy-seven cents).

Notes:

- (i) The readjustment rate in large companies is 20.69% and in small and medium companies it is 10.7%.
- (ii) Repealed Ministerial Order no. 30/2016 of 11 May which established the minimum salary in Sector 5 in 2016/2017.

SECTOR 6 - MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 36/2017 OF 12 MAY

(i) 5436.70 MT (five thousand four hundred and thirty-six meticais and seventy cents) for work in the construction sector.	(i) 4886.74 MT (four thousand eight hundred and eighty-six meticals and seventy-four cents).	
Notes:		
(i) The readjustment rate is 11,25%.		
(ii) Repealed Ministerial Order no. 31/2016 of 11 May which established the minimum salary in Sector 6 in 2016/2017.		

SECTOR 7 - MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 37/2017 OF 12 MAY		
Current Minimum Salary:	Previous Minimum Salary: 5.050 MT (five thousand and fifty meticais).	
(i) 5525 MT (five thousand five hundred and twenty-five meticais) for work in non-financial services;		
(ii) 5328 MT (five thousand three hundred and twenty-eight meticais) for the hotel subsector.		

Notes:

- (i) For 2017/2018, the hotel sector has been made independent.
- (ii) Therefore, the readjustment rate is 9.41% for non-financial services work, and 5.5% for the hotel subsector.
- (iii) Repealed Ministerial Order no. 32/2016 of 11 May which established the minimum salary in Sector 7 in 2016/2017.

SECTOR 8 - MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 38/2017 OF 12 MAY		
Current Minimum Salaries:	Previous Minimum Salaries:	
 (i) 10,400 MT (ten thousand four hundred meticais) for work in banks and insurance companies; (ii) 9240 MT (nine thousand two hundred and forty meticais) for work in micro-finances, micro-insurance and other ancillary financial intermediation work. 	(i) 8750 MT (eight thousand seven hundred and fifty meticais); and (ii) 8400 MT (eight thousand four hundred meticais).	

Notes:

- (i) The readjustment rate in banks and insurance companies, and micro-finances, micro-insurance and other ancillary financial intermediation work are 18.86% and 10%, respectively.
- (ii) Repealed Ministerial Order no. 33/2016 of 11 May which established the minimum salary in Sector 8 in 2016/2017.
