Café Nicola

A Brasileira, also known as Brasileira do Chiado, is one of Lisbon's most famous cafes. After opening in 1905, it became the place to meet for artists, writers and intellectuals like Fernando Pessoa, whose statue sits outside on the terrace.

The Antiga Confeitaria de Belém, better known as "Pasteis de Belém", has been making the famous Pastéis de Belém (custard tarts) since 1837 and they are de rigueur for anyone visiting Lisbon.

Almost 2 centuries old, this patisserie located in Praça da Figueira opened its doors in 1829 and was chosen to offer a selection from Europe's oldest and best patisseries. The house speciality of bolorei (kings' cake) is not to be missed.

Founded in 1922, the Versailles cafe and patisserie shares its name with the famous French palace and its interior will make you feel like you are actually there.
